2010 Season Report

Junior Girls

The Titans U-18 Women competed in both the Edmonton and Calgary leagues this past year and experienced great success in both. The girls emerged victorious in all of their games versus opponents from Calgary and finished the Edmonton regular season with the league's second best record.

Due to some unfortunate off-field issues the team was unable to compete in the Calgary city final. In the Edmonton league the girls defeated the Pirates in a semi-final game held in Red Deer and advanced to the League Championship game against the Strathcona Druids. Despite playing a solid and hard fought game, the Titan Women made a couple of mistakes which the Druids were able to capitalize on. These proved to be the difference and the Titans would end the year as the league's second best team, but with a new hunger to carry into the 2011 season.

In addition to league play, no less that 20 girls from the Red Deer Titans played rugby in the Alberta Summer Games, held in Peace River. Titans club members filled both their own Zone 4 team as well as the complete Zone 8 team. The Zone 4 girls went undefeated in round-robin play but could not sustain this effort into the playoffs. Losing their semi-final match, they were relegated to the bronze medal game and had to settle for a fourth place finish despite being one of the strongest teams in the tournament. The Zone 8 girls played well despite losing some players to injury. They were able to compete in every game and represent themselves well.

Christie Weiss was named the Most Valuable Back and Jen Petursun was named the Most Valuable Forward for the Red Deer Titan's Junior Women's Team at the 2010 Annual Awards Banquet.
